### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALE OF CERTAIN PACKAGED FRUITS, NUTS, VEGETABLES AND GRAINS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 96 of chapter 94 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after the first sentence the follow-  
3 ing new sentence: — Any such product sold in a package  
4 shall have posted thereon in letters one half inch high,  
5 the weight of the product contained therein.
