AN ACT PERMITTING CITIES AND TOWNS TO BORROW MONEY
IN ANTICIPATION OF CERTAIN PAYMENTS DUE FROM THE
COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:*

1 Chapter 44 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 6A the following new section: —
3 *Section 6B.* Cities and towns may borrow money in
4 anticipation of sums due, but not received, from the
5 commonwealth as reimbursement for money expended
6 for old age assistance, assistance to persons who are dis-
7 abled, and aid to dependent children, and issue notes
8 therefor for a period not exceeding six months from
9 their dates; and the proceeds of such reimbursement
10 shall be applied to the discharge of the loan.
