By Mr. Bliss of North Attleborough, petition of Carlton H. Bliss that clerks and assistant clerks of courts be permitted to elect to be classified under the County Personnel Board. Public Service.

AN ACT TO ENABLE CLERKS OF COURT TO BE CLASSIFIED UNDER THE COUNTY PERSONNEL BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 218, section 79, is hereby further amended
2 by adding to said section 79, as amended, the following:—
3 Clerks of court, assistant clerks, second and third
4 assistant clerks may elect to be classified under the
5 county personnel board as enacted under chapter
6 thirty-five, section forty-eight, and implemented under
7 section forty-nine, as amended, and if they so elect,
8 in writing, to said board, they shall be so classified,
9 notwithstanding the exceptions of clerks of court,
10 assistant clerks, and second and third assistant clerks,
11 under section forty-nine; provided, that no clerk of
12 court, assistant clerk or second or third assistant clerk
13 shall receive less than his present compensation, and
14 in any case no clerk of court shall receive less salary
15 than any other employee in his office after such classifi-
16 cation period.
