AN ACT MAKING THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE SOUTH BOSTON DISTRICT A FULL TIME COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 78 of chapter 218 of the General
2 Laws, as amended by chapter 741 of the acts of 1955,
3 is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 14 and 15,
4 the words:— municipal court of the South Boston dis-
5 trict.

1 SECTION 2. Section 77A of said chapter 218 is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the sentence inserted by sec-
3 tion 1 of chapter 805 of the acts of 1949, the following
4 new sentence:— The salary of the justice of the mu-
5 nicipal court of the South Boston district shall be twelve
