AN ACT REQUIRING THE DIVISION OF THE BLIND OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE FULL CARE OF THE BLIND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
