AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN PERSONS FROM THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN INCOME TAXES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 8 of chapter 62 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding after paragraph (k), added by chap-
- 3 ter 443 of the acts of 1954, the following paragraph:—
- 4 (l) Four thousand dollars in all, of income from all
- 5 sources, received by a blind person or a person above
- 6 the age of sixty-five years.
