

By Mr. Cartwright of Randolph, petition of Gordon P. MacGillvray and another that the Department of Public Works be authorized to excavate the channel and mooring basin in the Neponset River in Milton and Boston. Harbors and Public Lands.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE EXCAVATION AND DREDGING OF THE CHANNEL AND MOORING BASIN IN THE NEPONSET RIVER UPSTREAM WEST OF GRANITE AVENUE BRIDGE IN TOWN OF MILTON AND CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works, acting
2 through the division of waterways, is hereby authorized
3 and directed to excavate and dredge the channel and
4 mooring basin for yachts and small craft in the Neponset
5 river in the town of Milton and city of Boston, beginning
6 at a point on the westerly side of Granite avenue bridge
7 and proceeding upstream for a distance of approximately
8 one quarter of a mile, and to make such other improve-
9 ments as may be necessary to provide for unobstructed
10 passage of waters thereof and for prevention of flowage
11 of lands adjacent thereto.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes of section one of this
2 act, the department of public works may use any un-
3 expended balance previously appropriated, or any funds
4 which may be hereafter appropriated, for dredging of
5 channels and mooring basins in the waterways of the
6 commonwealth.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
