RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR A PROPER REPRESENTATION OF THE COMMONWEALTH AT THE NATIONAL CONVENTION OF THE ITALIAN-AMERICAN WORLD WAR VETERANS OF THE UNITED STATES, INC., TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD IN THE CURRENT YEAR.

1 *Resolved*, That, in order that the commonwealth may  
2 be properly represented on the occasion of the state con-  
3 vention of the Italian-American World War Veterans of  
4 the United States, Inc., to be held in the city of Spring-  
5 field in the current year, and to ensure, in arranging en-  
6 tertainments and other events in connection therewith,  
7 proper co-operation between the Italian-American World  
8 War Veterans of the United States, Inc., and the com-  
9 monwealth, after an appropriation has been made there-  
10 for, there may be expended, with the approval and under  
11 the direction of the governor and council, such sums as  
12 may be appropriated therefor.
