AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS
TO DREDGE AND RIPRAP THE GREEN RIVER IN THE TOWN
OF WILLIAMSTOWN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:*

1 The department of public works is hereby authorized
2 and directed to dredge and riprap the Green river from
3 the Wally bridge to a point below the Boston and Maine
4 Railroad sheds in the town of Williamstown. For said
5 purposes said department may expend, subject to appro-
6 priation, the sum of dollars, together with
7 the sum of dollars to be provided by the
8 town of Williamstown. No work shall be begun until
9 said town has deposited in the state treasury the sum of
10 dollars for the purposes herein set forth.
