RESOLUTIONS CONGRATULATING CHARLES JENKINS OF CAMBRIDGE.

Whereas, Charles Jenkins of Cambridge, a graduate of and former track star at Rindge Technical School in that city, and now an outstanding performer for Villanova College, this season has won the five hundred and fifty yard run at the New York A. C. games in New York, establishing a world record, the Prout six hundred yard run at the Knights of Columbus games in Boston, the Hollis six hundred yard run at the B. A. A. games in said city, thereby retiring the trophy and establishing a record, and the six hundred yard run at the Milrose games in New York; and

Whereas, He is recognized as the N. A. A. U. champion at four hundred and forty yards and as the N. I. C. A. A. A. champion at both four hundred and forty and six hundred yards; and

Whereas, He is further recognized as an outstanding prospect to represent the United States in the Olympic games in the current year; and

Whereas, The outstanding ability and fine sportsmanship of this young man has reflected credit on both his native city and the commonwealth; therefore be it

Resolved, That the Massachusetts house of representatives congratulates James Elliott, track coach at Villanova College, and Thomas Duffy, track coach at Rindge Technical School, for the part they have played in developing the athletic ability and sportsmanship of this fine young athlete; and be it further

Resolved, That the Massachusetts house of representatives recognizes the significant athletic achievements of Charles

Jenkins and hereby extends to him its sincere congratulations on his achievements to date and its best wishes for his further success; and be it further
