### AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE BYFIELD WATER DISTRICT TO MAKE AN ADDITIONAL WATER LOAN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of extending its water  
2 mains, the Byfield water district may borrow, from time  
3 to time, within five years from the passage of this act,  
4 such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding, in the  
5 aggregate, ten thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or  
6 notes therefor, which shall bear on their face the words,  
7 Byfield Water District Loan, Act of 1956. Each author-  
8 ized issue shall constitute a separate loan, and such loans  
9 shall be paid in not more than twenty years from their  
10 dates. Indebtedness incurred under authority of this  
11 act shall be outside the statutory limit of indebtedness,  
12 but shall, except as otherwise provided in this act, be  
13 subject to chapter forty-four of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
