RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BRIDGE FROM THE MAINLAND TO MARTHA'S VINEYARD.

Resolved, That an unpaid special commission, to con-2 sist of two members of the senate to be designated by 3 the president thereof, three members of the house of 4 representatives to be designated by the speaker thereof, 5 the director of the division of waterways of the depart-6 ment of public works or someone designated by him, 7 and two persons to be appointed by the governor, is 8 hereby established for the purpose of making an investi-9 gation and study relative to the construction of a bridge 10 from the mainland to Martha's Vineyard, which study 11 shall include the desirability and feasibility of construct-12 ing such a bridge, the estimated cost of construction and 13 maintenance and the methods of financing thereof. Said 14 commission shall be provided with quarters in the state 15 house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may travel within 16 and without the commonwealth and may expend for 17 clerical and other services and expenses such sums as 18 may be appropriated therefor. Said commission shall 19 report to the general court the results of its investiga-20 tion and study and its recommendations, if any, together 21 with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-22 mendations into effect by filing the same with the clerk 23 of the house of representatives not later than the first 24 Wednesday of December in the current year.
