RESOLVE AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BRIDGE FROM THE MAINLAND TO MARTHA'S VINEYARD.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public works is
2 hereby authorized and directed to make an investiga-
3 tion and study relative to the construction of a bridge
4 from the mainland to Martha's Vineyard, which study
5 shall include the desirability and feasibility of construct-
6 ing such a bridge, the estimated cost of construction and
7 maintenance, and the methods of financing thereof.
8 Said department shall report to the general court the
9 results of its investigation and study, and its recom-
10 mendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation
11 necessary to carry such recommendations into effect, by
12 filing the same with the clerk of the house of representa-
13 tives on or before the first Wednesday of December in
14 the current year.
