RESOLVE TO CONTINUE THE STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS OF DRAINAGE CONDITIONS IN THE DRAINAGE AREA OF THE SAUGUS RIVER AND ITS TRIBUTARIES IN THE TOWNS OF WAKEFIELD, READING, LYNNFIELD AND SAUGUS.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public works, au-
2 thorized and directed under chapter seventy-four of the
3 resolves of nineteen hundred and fifty-five to make a
4 study of the drainage area of the Saugus river and its
5 tributaries in the towns of Wakefield, Reading, Lynn-
6 field and Saugus, shall continue its investigation and
7 study until the first Wednesday of December in the
8 current year, at or before which time said department
9 shall report to the general court by filing a report with
10 the clerk of the house of representatives of the results
11 of its investigation and study, and its recommendations,
12 if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to
13 carry its recommendations into effect. For the purposes
14 of this resolve there may be expended such sums as may
15 hereafter be appropriated therefor.
