## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Six.

RESOLVE AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO INITIATE, PROMOTE AND SPONSOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A STEEL MILL AND AN ALUMINUM MILL WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of commerce is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to initiate, promote and sponsor,  
3 through a committee to be appointed by said depart-  
4 ment, said committee to be subject to the control and  
5 direction of said department, the establishment, by pri-  
6 vate industry and capital, of a steel mill and an aluminum  
7 mill within the commonwealth. In making its study and  
8 investigation and in the promotion of the purposes of  
9 this resolve, said committee shall consider the subject  
10 matter of current House document numbered 2457, being  
11 the preliminary report of the special commission estab-  
12 lished by chapter one hundred and fifteen of the resolves  
13 of nineteen hundred and fifty-four and revived and con-  
14 tinued by chapter one hundred and thirty-six of the  
15 resolves of nineteen hundred and fifty-five, for the pur-  
16 pose of making an investigation and study relative to the  
17 erection of a steel mill or mills and an aluminum mill or  
18 mills within the commonwealth, to the end that the  
19 recommendations in said report be brought to a success-  
20 ful conclusion. For the purposes of this resolve said  
21 committee may expend such sums as may be appro-  
22 priated therefor.
