## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Six.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO SELL CERTAIN  
LAND IN THE WEST ROXBURY DISTRICT OF SAID CITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,  
as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any contrary provision  
2 of general or special law, the city of Boston, by its  
3 mayor, may sell at public auction or private sale any  
4 part or parts or the whole of the land held by said city  
5 for park department purposes under the order of taking  
6 recorded with Suffolk Deeds, Book 6937, Page 149,  
7 on February sixteenth in the year nineteen hundred and  
8 fifty-four and of the interest in land held by said city  
9 for such purposes under the order of taking recorded  
10 with Suffolk Deeds, Book 6942, Page 546, on March  
11 fifteenth in said year; provided, that the parks and  
12 recreation commission of said city shall, by vote at a  
13 regular or special meeting of said commission, assent  
14 to the sale; and provided, further, that the sale is  
15 authorized, after two separate readings, by two separate  
16 votes of two thirds of all the members of the city council  
17 of said city, the second of said readings and votes to  
18 be had not less than fourteen days after the first.

1 SECTION 2. The mayor of said city, in the name and  
2 on behalf of said city, shall execute and deliver any  
3 instrument necessary to convey any land or interest  
4 therein sold under authority of this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
