AN ACT PROHIBITING THE SENDING OF BILLS FOR GAS OR ELECTRICITY ON OPEN POSTAL CARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 164 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting after section 119A the following section: —
- 3 *Section 119B.* No bill or statement to a consumer for
- 4 charges for gas or electricity shall be sent by means of
- 5 an open postal card.
