AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF WATERTOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 If any fire alarm signal operator of the town of
2 Watertown is required to serve a tour of duty during
3 the twenty-four hour period commencing at 12.01 in
4 the morning of January first, February twenty-second,
5 April nineteenth, May thirtieth, July fourth, the first
6 Monday in September, October twelfth, November
7 eleventh, Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day, or the
8 day following when any of the five days first mentioned
9 or October twelfth, November eleventh or Christmas
10 Day occurs on Sunday, he shall be given an additional
11 day off; provided, that if such additional day off cannot
12 be given because of personnel shortage or other cause,
13 such operator shall be entitled to an additional day's
14 pay in lieu thereof.
