## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Six.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF DEDHAM TO BORROW MONEY OUTSIDE THE DEBT LIMIT FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 For the purpose of improving Wigwam brook and the  
2 meadow land adjacent thereto, the town of Dedham  
3 may borrow, from time to time, within a period of five  
4 years from the passage of this act, such sums as may be  
5 necessary not exceeding in the aggregate three hundred  
6 thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes therefor  
7 which shall bear on their face the words, town of Ded-  
8 ham, Brook Improvement Loan, Act of 1956. Each  
9 authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan, and such  
10 loans shall be paid in not more than ten years from their  
11 dates. Indebtedness incurred under this act shall be in  
12 excess of the statutory limit, but shall, except as herein  
13 provided, be subject to chapter forty-four of the General  
14 Laws exclusive of the limitation contained in the first  
15 paragraph of section seven thereof.
