AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MALDEN TO PAY AN ANNUITY TO THE WIDOW OF THE LATE SWANSEY BANKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. In recognition of long and meritorious
2 service and for the purpose of promoting the public
3 good, the city of Malden may, notwithstanding the pro-
4 visions of any general or special law, appropriate and
5 pay an annual pension to Laura Banks, widow of the
6 late Swansey Banks, in the amount of one thousand six
7 hundred and sixty-two dollars and forty cents, payable
8 in equal monthly instalments.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
