By Mr. Amoroso of Natick, petition of Leonard H. Amoroso (by vote of the town) for legislation to authorize the town of Natick to pay certain medical bills incurred by John P. Daley, a former employee of the public works department of said town. Municipal Finance.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF NATICK TO PAY CERTAIN MEDICAL BILLS OF JOHN P. DALEY, A DECEASED EMPLOYEE OF SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a moral
2 obligation, the town of Natick may pay the sum of one
3 thousand dollars for medical expenses of John P. Daley
4 incurred on account of injuries received by him in the
5 performance of his duty as an employee of the public
6 works department of said town from which injuries he
7 subsequently died.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
