RESOLVE AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO REQUIRING CABOOSSES, SO CALLED, OPERATED BY RAILROAD CORPORATIONS IN THIS COMMONWEALTH TO BE EQUIPPED WITH ELECTRIC LIGHTS.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public utilities is
2 hereby authorized and directed to make an investigation
3 and study of the subject matter of the investigation pro-
4 posed by current house document numbered 2709, rela-
5 tive to requiring cabooses, so called, operated by rail-
6 road corporations in this commonwealth to be equipped
7 with electric lights. Said department shall report to the
8 general court the results of its investigation and study,
9 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
10 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the
11 clerk of the house of representatives from time to time
12 but not later than the last Monday of December in the
13 current year.
