The committees on Rules of the two branches, acting concurrently, to whom were referred the Resolve providing for an investigation and study by a special commission relative to the elimination of noxious fumes from motor vehicles, the construction of certain highways, underpasses and tunnels to alleviate and regulate traffic, and to establish a central authority for highway construction projects (House, No. 2976), the Resolve providing for an investigation and study by an unpaid special commission relative to safety equipment on motor vehicles and other related matters (House, No. 2977), and the Resolve providing for an investigation and study by a special commission of certain matters relative to the construction, use, care and control of highways, the construction of certain bridges and grade separations and the designation of certain bridges and highways (House, No. 2993), report that the same ought to pass in the form of a new draft herewith submitted (House, No. 3053).

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION OF CERTAIN MATTERS RELATIVE TO THE USE, CARE, DESIGNATION, CONTROL AND CONSTRUCTION OF HIGHWAYS AND BRIDGES, THE ELIMINATION OF NOXIOUS FUMES FROM AND REQUIRING SAFETY EQUIPMENT ON MOTOR VEHICLES, AND OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to con-  
2 sist of two members of the senate to be designated by  
3 the president thereof, three members of the house of  
4 representatives to be designated by the speaker thereof,  
5 one person to be appointed by the governor, the registrar  
6 of motor vehicles or a person in his department desig-  
7 nated by him, and the commissioner of public works or  
8 a person in his department designated by him, is hereby  
9 established for the purpose of making an investigation  
10 and study of the subject matter of the investigation and  
11 study proposed by current house document numbered  
12 2993, relative to the construction, use, care and control  
13 of highways, the construction of certain bridges and  
14 grade separations and the designation of certain bridges  
15 and highways; of the investigation and study proposed  
16 by current house document numbered 2976, relative to  
17 the elimination of noxious fumes from motor vehicles,  
18 the construction of certain highways, underpasses and  
19 tunnels to alleviate and regulate traffic, and to establish  
20 a central authority for highway construction projects;  
21 of the investigation and study proposed by current  
22 house document numbered 2977, relative to safety equip-  
23 ment on motor vehicles and other related matters.  
24 Said commission shall be provided with quarters in the  
25 state house or elsewhere, may hold hearings and may  
26 expend for legal, clerical and other assistance and for

27 expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor.  
28 Said commission shall report to the general court the  
29 results of its investigation and study, and its recom-  
30 mendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation  
31 necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by  
32 filing the same with the clerk of the house of representa-  
33 tives on or before the last Monday of December in the  
34 current year.
