
By Mr. Bly of Saugus, petition of Mason Condon (selectman) relative to the control of all ponds or lakes in the town of Lynnfield. Towns.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Six.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CONTROL OF ALL PONDS OR LAKES OR PORTIONS THEREOF IN THE TOWN OF LYNNFIELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Lynnfield, through its board
2 of selectmen, may from time to time make rules and regu-
3 lations governing fishing, boating, bathing, skating and
4 other recreational activities in or on the ponds or lakes or
5 any portions thereof in the town of Lynnfield. Such
6 rules and regulations relative to fishing shall be subject
7 to the approval of the division of fisheries and game of
8 the department of natural resources, and such other rules
9 and regulations shall be subject to the approval of the
10 state department of public works, and when so approved
11 shall have the force of law.

1 SECTION 2. The town of Lynnfield, through its board
2 of selectmen, may from time to time make rules and
3 regulations as to the erection, maintenance and control
4 of all public bathhouses on the shores of the ponds or
5 lakes in which bathing is permitted in said town.

1 SECTION 3. Any police officer of said town may patrol
2 any part of the waters of said ponds and lakes, and shall
3 have authority to arrest any person violating any law of
4 the commonwealth in, on or adjacent to the waters of

5 said lakes and ponds or violating any rule or regulation
6 established under this act.

1 SECTION 4. The violation of any rule or regulation
2 established under this act shall be punished by a fine of
3 not more than twenty dollars.

1 SECTION 5. Nothing in this act shall be construed to
2 abridge the powers and duties of said department of
3 public works under chapter ninety-one of the General
4 Laws.

1 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
