### AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF HOME FOR AGED MEN TO ROGERSON HOUSE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The name of the Home for Aged Men,  
2 incorporated by chapter one hundred and fifty-three of  
3 the special acts of eighteen hundred and sixty, is hereby  
4 changed to, and said corporation shall hereafter be  
5 known as, Rogerson House; and any gift, devise or  
6 bequest made, or which shall hereafter be made, to the  
7 said corporation by its old name shall enure to its benefit  
8 in like manner as it would have done had its name not  
9 been changed.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
