### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CARRYING OF CONCEALED WEAPONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 269 of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by inserting after section 10B the following section:—  
3 *Section 10C.* Any person found carrying a concealed  
4 loaded gun on his person, or an unloaded gun with cart-  
5 ridges in his possession, without a license to carry the  
6 same shall, for the first offence be punished by a manda-  
7 tory sentence of imprisonment for a period of ten years,  
8 and for a second offence of the same crime shall receive  
9 a mandatory sentence of life imprisonment.
