To accompany the petition of Frederick T. McDermott for legislation to provide that in the sale of alcoholic beverages to be consumed on the premises certain information as to the contents be made available to the purchaser. Legal Affairs.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Six.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT IN THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO BE CONSUMED ON THE PREMISES CERTAIN INFORMATION AS TO THE CONTENTS BE AVAILABLE TO THE PURCHASER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 A common victualler duly licensed under chapter one
2 hundred and forty of the General Laws to conduct a
3 restaurant, an innholder duly licensed under said chap-
4 ter to conduct a hotel, and each keeper of a tavern as
5 defined in chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the
6 General Laws, licensed to sell alcoholic beverages to be
7 drunk on the premises as provided in said chapter one
8 hundred and thirty-eight, shall print on the menu or
9 price list containing the prices of the alcoholic beverages
10 offered for sale therein the number of ounces of alcoholic
11 beverage served in such drink, or if there is no such
12 printed menu or price list shall post in a conspicuous
13 place a sign bearing the prices of drinks offered for sale
14 and the number of ounces of alcoholic beverage served
15 in said drinks.
