AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF WEIGHERS, MEASURERS AND SURVEYORS OF COMMODITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 striking out section 85 and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 following section:—
- 4 *Section 85.* The mayor or the selectmen shall appoint
- 5 weighers, measurers and surveyors who are resident of
- 6 the city or town where appointed, and shall serve for a
- 7 term of one or three years as the city or town shall vote.
- 8 They shall be sworn before entering upon their duties.
- 9 Persons so appointed shall be disinterested parties to
- 10 any dispute which they are called upon to settle, and
- 11 shall not act in any matter relating to a business in
- 12 which they are engaged.
