AN ACT DESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF STATE HIGHWAY,  
ROUTE 28, IN THE CITY OF MEDFORD AS THE JAMES C.  
GILLIS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 So much of state highway Route 28 as is located in the  
2 city of Medford shall upon its completion be designated  
3 and known as the James C. Gillis Memorial Highway and  
4 suitable tablets and markers bearing said designation  
5 shall be erected at appropriate places thereon by the  
6 department of public works.
