AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN BRIDGE OVER THE MERRIMACK RIVER, IN THE CITY OF LOWELL, AS THE QUINN-HOLMES MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 4 nated as the Quinn-Holmes Memorial Bridge.
