AN ACT EXCLUDING SECONDARY INCOME IN DETERMINING THE NET INCOME OF TENANTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING THE RENT TO BE CHARGED IN CERTAIN HOUSING PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 In computing the rental to be charged for units in a
- 2 housing project the net income of the tenant shall be
- 3 figured, exclusive of any income received by members
- 4 of the household other than the principal wage earner.
