RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY
RELATIVE TO THE ADVISABILITY AND FEASIBILITY OF THE
COMMONWEALTH PROVIDING LOANS TO LOCAL INDUSTRIAL
DEVELOPMENT CORPORATIONS.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to con-
2 sist of two members of the senate to be designated by the
3 president thereof, three members of the house of repre-
4 sentatives to be designated by the speaker thereof, the
5 commissioner of commerce or his designee, and tree per-
6 sons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby estab-
7 lished for the purpose of making a thorough investigation
8 and study relative to the advisability and feasibility of
9 providing loans and grants in aid by the commonwealth
10 for the purpose of aiding local industrial corporations,
11 with a view to recommending such changes in the laws or
12 such additions thereto, as the commission may deem ad-
13 visable. Said commission shall be provided with quarters
14 in the state house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may
15 travel within or without the commonwealth and may
16 expend for legal, clerical and other assistance such sums
17 as may be appropriated therefor. Said commission shall
18 report to the general court the results of its investigation
19 and study, and its recommendations, if any, together
20 with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recom-
21 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk
22 of the house of representatives not later than the third
23 Wednesday of December in the current year.
