
To accompany the petition of Brig. Gen. Timothy J. Regan, Jr., for legislation transferring from the Metropolitan District Commission to the military department the care, custody and control of certain park lands in the West Roxbury district of the city of Boston. Metropolitan Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT TRANSFERRING FROM THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO THE MILITARY DEPARTMENT THE CARE, CUSTODY AND CONTROL OF CERTAIN PARK LANDS IN THE WEST ROXBURY DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The military department shall hereafter
2 have the care, custody and control of a certain parcel of
3 land, being a part of the land taken by eminent domain
4 by the metropolitan park commission for boulevard
5 purposes and situated in the West Roxbury district of
6 the city of Boston, at the northwesterly junction of
7 Washington street and LaGrange street.

8 Bounded on the southeast by the northwesterly side
9 line of Washington street, about 400 feet; bounded
10 northeasterly by other land of the said commission,
11 about 300 feet; bounded northwesterly by other land of
12 the said commission, about 400 feet; and bounded south-
13 westerly by the northeasterly side line of LaGrange
14 street, about 300 feet; containing approximately 120,000
15 square feet.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

The Commentaries of Cassin

in the Year One Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty

For the purpose of giving the most complete and accurate information to the public in regard to the various lands owned by the Government, the following list of the various lands owned by the Government is published, and the same is to be printed in the next issue of the Report.

The lands owned by the Government are divided into three classes, to-wit: (1) lands owned by the Government in fee simple; (2) lands owned by the Government in trust; and (3) lands owned by the Government in reversion.

1. Section 1. The military department shall include
2. All the lands which are owned in a certain part of
3. land being a part of the land which is within the limits
4. of the military department, and which are owned in
5. fee simple, and situated in the West, between the
6. 40th and 45th parallels, and between the
7. 100th and 110th meridians.
8. Situated on the northeast of the northwestern side
9. of the Washington street, about 200 feet
10. northwards, in other land of the said
11. section 800 feet; bounded northwards by water and by
12. the said commission, about 400 feet; and bounded east-
13. wards by the northwestern side line of
14. section 800 feet, containing approximately 120,000
15. square feet.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
