The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Six.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONVEY A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN CAMBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of chap-
2 ter four hundred and ninety-one of the acts of nineteen
3 hundred and fifty-one the metropolitan district com-
4 mission, in the name and behalf of the commonwealth,
5 with the approval of the Metropolitan Transit Author-
6 ity, is hereby authorized and directed to convey to the
7 city of Cambridge for nominal consideration, for street
8 purposes, a parcel of land in Cambridge, Massachu-
9 setts, bounded and described as follows:—beginning
10 at a point in the western boundary of land now or late
11 of Gerald W. Blakely, Jr., *et als*, Trustees, distant 193.45
12 feet on bearing south 16° 22' 16" east from the easterly
13 corner of land now or late of Marshall B. Dalton *et als*,
14 Trustees (Land Court Case No. 25,650), thence south
15 16° 22' 16" east by said land now or late of Blakely *et*
16 *als*, Trustees, and by Acorn park presently laid out as
17 a public way, a distance of 47.04 feet; thence turning
18 and running north 89° 26' 46" west by land now or
19 formerly of the commonwealth of Massachusetts, a

20 distance of 612.54 feet; thence turning and running in
21 a northeasterly direction by a curved line with a radius
22 of 904.80 feet, a distance of 30.95 feet; thence turning
23 slightly and running along a curved line with a radius
24 of 5453.83 feet, a distance of 97.82 feet, the last two
25 lines being by land of said Dalton *et als*, Trustees;
26 thence turning and running south $89^{\circ} 26' 46''$ east by
27 other land now or formerly of the commonwealth of
28 Massachusetts, a distance of 478.21 feet to the point
29 of beginning, the second and last described lines being
30 parallel and 45 feet apart at right angles, containing
31 24,486 square feet, being the land marked "Proposed
32 Extension of Acorn Park, on Plan of Land in Cambridge
33 and Arlington, William S. Crocker, Civil Engineer,
34 dated November 18, 1955."

1 SECTION 2. This conveyance shall be subject to such
2 easements for drainage or otherwise as shall be deter-
3 mined by the metropolitan district commission.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
