AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A MINIMUM RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE FOR CERTAIN PUBLIC EMPLOYEES AFTER THIRTY-FIVE YEARS OF SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

4 amended by adding at the end the following sentence: —
5 The guaranteed minimum retirement allowance at age
