To accompany the petition of the Federation of State, City and Town Employees, by Patrick A. Golden, that provision be made for the payment of accumulated sick leave after the retirement or decease of an employee of a city or town. Public Service.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF ACCUMULATED SICK LEAVE AFTER THE RETIREMENT OR DECEASE OF AN EMPLOYEE OF A CITY OR TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 111I the following section:—
- 3 *Section 111J.* Whenever an officer or employee of a
- 4 city or town retires or dies any accumulated sick leave
- 5 to which he was entitled shall be paid to him or, in the
- 6 event of his decease, to his survivors, in the form of
- 7 compensation at the rate of his salary at the time of his
- 8 retirement.
