To accompany the petition of Charles V. Hogan that provision be made for the appointment of a second officer for attendance upon the sessions of the Land Court in Suffolk County. Public Service.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A SECOND OFFICER FOR ATTENDANCE UPON THE SESSIONS OF THE LAND COURT IN SUFFOLK COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 185 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out section 13, as appearing in the Ter-
3 centenary Edition, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following section: —

5 *Section 13.* Upon request of the judges, the sheriff of
6 any county other than Suffolk shall assign a deputy to
7 attend the sittings of the land court in that county.
8 The judges shall appoint two officers for attendance
9 upon the sessions of said court in Suffolk county.
