RESOLVE ESTABLISHING AN UNPAID SPECIAL COMMISSION TO
STUDY AND REVISE THE LAWS RELATING TO PUBLIC WEL-
FARE.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to con-
2 sist of two members of the senate to be designated by
3 the president thereof, three members of the house of
4 representatives to be designated by the speaker thereof,
5 and two persons to be appointed by the governor, is
6 hereby established to make a survey and study of the
7 laws of the commonwealth relating to public welfare,
8 with a view to the revision and codification of said laws
9 and to the recommendation of such changes therein and
10 additions thereto as may appear necessary or desirable.
11 Said commission shall hold hearings, shall be provided
12 with quarters in the state house or elsewhere, and may
13 expend for legal, clerical and other assistance and for
14 expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
15 Said commission shall report to the general court the
16 results of its study, and its recommendations, if any,
17 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry
18 said recommendations into effect, by filing the same with
19 the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the
20 first Wednesday of March in the year nineteen hundred
21 and fifty-seven.
