AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE NON-CRIMINAL DISPOSITION OF  
PARKING VIOLATIONS IN THE BACK BAY AREA OF THE  
CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The second paragraph of section 20A of  
2 chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1  
3 of chapter 249 of the acts of 1953, is hereby amended  
4 by inserting after the word "Boston", in line 19, and  
5 in line 21, in each instance, the words: — or in the back  
6 bay area of the city of Boston, as defined in section  
7 twenty B.

1 SECTION 2. Said chapter 90 is hereby further amended  
2 by inserting after said section 20A the following sec-  
3 tion: —  
4 *Section 20B.* The words "back bay area of the city  
5 of Boston" as used in section twenty A shall be deemed  
6 to mean that part of the city of Boston bounded by an  
7 imaginary line starting at Park square and drawn  
8 through Columbus avenue, including both sides of said  
9 avenue, to Clarendon street, thence turning on said  
10 Clarendon street and proceeding along said Clarendon  
11 street, including both sides of said street, to Newbury  
12 street, thence turning on said Newbury street and

13 proceeding along said Newbury street, including both  
14 sides of said street, to Arlington street, thence turning  
15 left on said Arlington street, proceeding along the center  
16 of said street to Beacon street, thence turning right on  
17 said Beacon street, proceeding up Beacon street on the  
18 public garden side to Charles street, thence by the public  
19 gardens on Charles street, but not including either side  
20 of Charles street, to the point of beginning.
