To accompany the petition of Charles A. Frates and others for legislation to amend the law relative to the water supply for the Bristol County Agricultural School. Water Supply.

AN ACT AMENDING THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE WATER SUPPLY FOR THE BRISTOL COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SCHOOL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 392 of the acts of
2 1941 is hereby amended by striking out in lines 2 and 3
3 the words: — “South Dighton Fire and Water District”
4 and inserting in place thereof the words: — Dighton
5 Water Supply District.

1 SECTION 2. The acts of the trustees of the Bristol
2 County Agricultural School in selling water for domestic
3 use prior to the effective date of this act are hereby
4 validated.

1 SECTION 3. The trustees are hereby authorized to
2 continue and/or to extend the sale of water for domestic
3 use to owners of property abutting the school water
4 mains, so long as they cannot be served by a public
5 water supply district.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
