RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A RETAIL MARKET AREA IN THE CITY OF BOSTON FOR THE OCCUPANCY OF STREET STANDS.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, consist-
2 ing of two members of the senate to be designated by
3 the president thereof, three members of the house of
4 representatives, to be designated by the speaker thereof,
5 one person to be appointed by the governor, two per-
6 sons to be appointed by the mayor of the city of Boston,
7 and the commissioner of the state department of pub-
8 lic works or a person designated by him, is hereby es-
9 tablished to make an investigation and study of the
10 problem of designating a certain area in the downtown
11 section of the city of Boston as a market area for the
12 sale of fresh provisions or perishable produce or other
13 merchandise from street stands or trucks, pushearts or
14 other vehicles, with a view to protecting the livelihood
15 of the vendors and pedlars whose businesses have been
16 seriously affected by reason of the construction of the
17 Boston Central Artery. Said commission shall be pro-
18 vided with quarters in the state house or elsewhere,
19 may hold public hearings and may expend for clerical
20 and other services such sums as may be appropriated
21 therefor. Said commission shall report to the general
22 court the results of its investigation and study, and its
23 recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legis-
24 lation necessary to carry such recommendations into
25 effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of
26 representatives not later than the first Wednesday of
27 December in the current year.
