AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARIES OF THE REGISTER OF DEEDS AND ASSISTANT REGISTERS OF DEEDS FOR THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The second paragraph of section 33 of chapter 36 of
2 the General Laws, as appearing in chapter 543 of the
3 acts of 1952, is hereby further amended by striking out
4 the word "eleven" as appearing in the second line and
5 inserting in place thereof the word:— thirteen, — by
6 striking out the word "seventy-five" as appearing in
7 the third and fourth lines and inserting in place thereof
8 the word:— eighty-eight, — and by striking out the
9 words "seven thousand" as appearing in the fifth line
10 and inserting in place thereof the words:— eighty-two
11 hundred, — so as to read as follows:— The salary of
12 the register of deeds for the county of Suffolk shall be
13 thirteen thousand dollars, the salary of the first assist-
14 ant register of deeds for said county shall be eighty-eight
15 hundred dollars, and the salaries of all other assistant
16 registers of deeds for said county shall be eighty-two
17 hundred dollars.
