RESOLUTIONS CONGRATULATING HAROLD CONNOLLY, HOLDER OF THE WORLD RECORD IN THE HAMMER THROW.

Whereas, Harold Connolly of Brighton, a distinguished nephew of Senator James J. Corbett and member of the United States Olympic team, and the first American ever to exceed two hundred feet in the hammer throw, has established a new world mark in the hammer throw by smashing the Russian held world record with a throw of well over two hundred and eighteen feet; therefore be it
