AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POPULATION OF CITIES AND THE COMPENSATION OF CITY MANAGERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 89 of chapter 43 of the General Laws, as amended,
2 is hereby further amended by striking out the third sentence
3 in the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the fol-
4 lowing:— He shall hold office during the pleasure of the city
5 council and shall receive such compensation as it shall fix by
6 ordinance, but not exceeding ten thousand dollars annually
7 in cities having a population of less than fifty thousand or
8 twenty thousand dollars annually in cities having a popula-
9 tion of fifty thousand or more.
