AN ACT PROVIDING THAT LAND SOLD TO SATISFY CERTAIN
ESTABLISHED LIENS SHALL NOT BE SUBJECT TO REDEMPTION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 254 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 striking out section 20, as appearing in the Tercentenary
- 3 Edition, and inserting in place thereof the following section: —
- 4 *Section 20.* An interest in land sold under this chapter shall
- 5 forever foreclose the right of redemption.
