AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE CLERKS OF CERTAIN  
DISTRICT COURTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 79 of chapter 218 of the General Laws,  
2 as most recently amended by section 6 of chapter 738 of the  
3 acts of 1956, is hereby further amended by striking out, in  
4 line 9, the word "nine" and inserting in place thereof the  
5 word: — twelve.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July first, nine-  
2 teen hundred and fifty-seven.

It is the policy of the State to encourage the development of the State's resources and to provide for the conservation of the State's natural resources.

### The Constitution of Massachusetts

THE SENATE HAS THE HONOR TO ANNOUNCE THE RESULTS OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE LANDS AND FORESTS REPORT.

The report is divided into two parts, the first part containing the report of the Commission on the Lands and Forests, and the second part containing the report of the Commission on the State's Natural Resources.

Section 1. The Commission on the Lands and Forests has the honor to report that the State's lands and forests are in a state of general neglect and that the State's natural resources are being rapidly depleted.

Section 2. This act shall take effect on July first, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven.
