AN ACT ESTABLISHING A STATE SONG.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 2 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding at the end thereof the following section:—
3 *Section 10.* The composition consisting of the words and
4 the music known as or entitled “Massachusetts” and the
5 original work of and by Martha Harris Hastings of Hyannis
6 is designated the song of the commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
