AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF CERTAIN JUSTICES OF THE SUPREME JUDICIAL COURT AND OF THE SUPERIOR COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 333 of the acts of 1956 is hereby
2 amended by striking out section 2 and inserting in place
3 thereof the following section:—

4 *Section 2.* This act shall take effect as of October first,
5 nineteen hundred and fifty-five.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section four
2 of chapter seven hundred and thirty-three of the acts of
3 nineteen hundred and fifty-five, any justice of the supreme
4 judicial court who was appointed to said office between the
5 first day of January and the thirty-first day of December in
6 the year nineteen hundred and fifty-six, both dates inclusive,
7 shall receive such salary as is provided by section twenty-two
8 of chapter two hundred and eleven of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section four
2 of chapter seven hundred and thirty-three of the acts of
3 nineteen hundred and fifty-five, any justice of the superior
4 court who was appointed to said office between the first day
5 of February, nineteen hundred and fifty-six and the thirty-
6 first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-six, both
7 dates inclusive, shall receive such salary as is provided by
8 section twenty-seven of chapter two hundred and twelve of
9 the General Laws.

1 SECTION 4. Sections two and three of this act shall take
2 effect as of August first, nineteen hundred and fifty-six.
