## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Seven.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISSEMINATION OF DATA AND STATISTICS AS TO THE PRODUCTION AND MARKETING OF HORTICULTURAL PRODUCTS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of chapter 128 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out paragraph (d), as appearing in the  
3 Tercentenary Edition, and inserting in place thereof the  
4 following paragraph: —

5 (d) Collect and disseminate data and statistics as to the  
6 food, flowers and other horticultural products produced,  
7 marketed, stored or held within the commonwealth, with the  
8 quantities available from time to time and the location thereof.
