AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE BLOOD TYPE OF EACH PERSON TO WHOM A SPORTING OR HUNTING LICENSE IS ISSUED SHALL BE NOTED ON SUCH LICENSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6 of chapter 131 of the General Laws, as amended,
2 is hereby further amended by inserting after the first sentence
3 the following sentence:— Each applicant for a sporting and
4 hunting license shall furnish the director or the clerk of any city
5 or town with a certificate from a hospital or a physician indicat-
6 ing his blood type, and such information shall be noted on such
7 license.
